UN-Definition of Genocide

killings or other related acts committed with intent to destroy, in whole or in part, a national, ethnical, racial

or religious group

Genocide Convention 1948



Concept of Genocide

Cultural Act Five punishable acts (physical, biological) destruction Victim group Four groups Narrow definition (national, ethnical, of genocide racial, religious) (UN-definition) Cultural genocide Political groups, Broader definition groups arbitrarily of Genocide determined by the perpetrators



Modern-age Genocide

- Nature and scale
- Characteristics of modernity
 - * Progress in technology and science
 - * Development of nation state and nationalism
 - * Formation of mass democracy
 - * Establishment of colonialism and its reconfiguration etc.
- Genocide in conjunction with darker side of modernity



Genocide Purpose Analysis

Four major types

- 1. Creation or reconfiguration of nation state
- 2. Exploitation of natural and human resources
- 3. Consolidation of the dictatorial power base
- 4. Ensuring victory in external or civil war

In reality:

Complex phenomena with multiple purposes

- * Genocide not as an inevitable result of "ancient hatreds"




Bottom Line of Preventing Genocide
